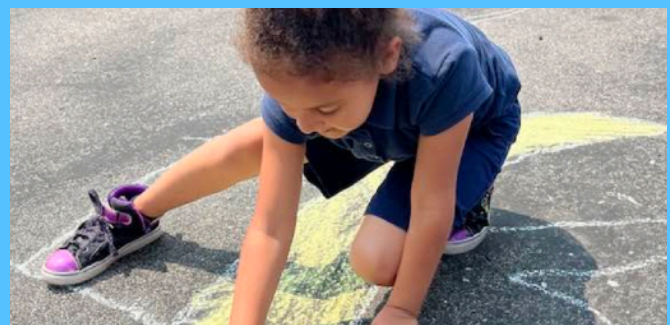
OUTDOOR EDUCATION

Our farm features 25 raised garden beds, trellis climbing vines, wind and solar power, compost, rainwater collection, chickens, and honey bees. A humble fruit orchard, rolling green meadow, wooded perimeter, and a creek round out the school's outdoor offerings.

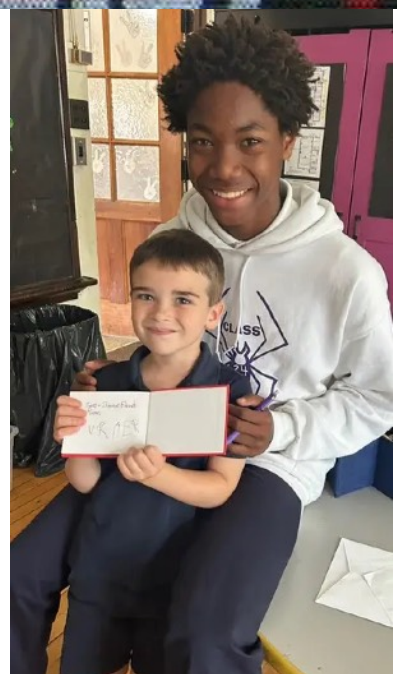

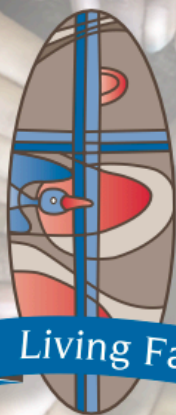
